

## **Workshop 1: Driving-related Performance Assessment and Standardized Driving Observation**

The Workshop focuses on the performance criteria of driving fitness and the psychological assessment of driving-related executive functions, as well as the compensation options in the case of insufficient performance outcomes. The aim is to discuss the examination of options for compensation within the testing situation itself as well as the conduct of standardized driving observations.

Another main topic of the workshop will be the assessment of driving-related performance of persons with visual problems (neglects and hemianopsia) and the support from the use of driving simulators.
